



132 Column Font

What It Is

COLD/ERM systems provide tremendous financial, storage, and retrieval benefits to companies that utilize this area of document management technology. Traditional COLD/ERM systems limit users to viewing all but a few columns of a traditional 132-column report on an 800 x 600 resolution screen. To view the remaining sections of these reports, users must scroll to the right to view the rest of the report data. The 132 column font provides a mechanism for viewing entire on a single screen.

How It Works

OnBase users can now view a complete 132-character wide report in 800 x 600 or a 166-character wide report in 1024 x 768 screen resolution without having to scroll right and left to find the information they are seeking. This uniquely designed font allows users to associate their large report document types with this font to make the navigation, viewing and analyzing of important data less painful.
